

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-35

RESOLUTION OF THE GLENN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FORMING
THE GLENN COUNTY OLIVE FRUIT PEST MANAGEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2002 the petitioner submitted petitions to initiate proceedings for the formation of the Glenn County Olive Fruit Pest Management District.

WHEREAS, the proposal for the District formation was filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and the required public hearing was held on April 2, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Glenn County Board of Supervisors heard, discussed and considered all oral and written testimony for and against the District Formation including the Agricultural Commissioners investigation and report; and

WHEREAS, a description of the boundaries of the above cited District Formation is shown on the attached map, marked "Exhibit A", which is the whole of Glenn County and by reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the Glenn County Board of Supervisors deems it in the public interest to form the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS ARE MADE:

1. The Glenn County Board of Supervisors accepted petitions, presented at their regular meeting held on February 19, 2002, requesting the formation of the Glenn County Olive Fruit Pest Management District.
2. That petitions filed with the Board of Supervisors were investigated and reported on by the Agricultural Commissioner as being accurate and true and represented the minimum of 51% by area of land devoted exclusively to the growing of olives in the proposed district within the county.
3. That the petitions and hearing notices informed the public and landowners that an assessment may be levied on parcels with 10 or more olive trees.
4. That a public hearing was held on April 2, 2002 at 10:00 am allowing persons interested in the formation of the District to be heard.
5. That the project is feasible and in the interest of the olive growers of the county.
6. That the Glenn County Board of Supervisors does hereby declare the District duly organized.

7. That the Glenn County Board of Supervisors does hereby appoint the Board of Directors of the Glenn County Olive Fruit Pest Management District, as follows:

- b. James Aguiar
- c. Merrit Erickson
- d. Scott Studybaker
- e. Dennis Burreson
- f. Greg Overton - Alternate
- g. Mike Verschagin - Alternate
- h. Chuck Schonauer - Alternate

8. That the County Assessor's Office be provided with a legal description of the District.




