PLANNING YOUR TRIP

Check the schedule for the bus route location and time that best suits your destination needs.

- Trip routes are listed by community (on the left side). Top of schedule (green border) are trip times heading to Chico. Read down the schedule. Return trip times (yellow border) are heading to Glenn County.
- "NO SERVICE" bus stop listings—bus does not go by stops listed "NO SERVICE" on express route only for trip #1.
- Arrive a minimum of five (5) minutes before your bus is scheduled to leave.
- When bus approaches the bus stop, stand near the bus stop sign and make sure the driver can see you. Stay out of street at all times.
- Have exact fare or bus passes ready when you board the bus. The driver cannot provide change if you pay more than the posted cash fare.
- Departing the bus—pull the "stop request" cord above the window prior to your stop. Give the driver enough notice for a safe stop.

HOLIDAYS

Closed on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Reduced service is available on the following days: Martin Luther King's Birthday, Presidents Day, Veterans Day, the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and New Year's Eve. Refer to 3-trip Saturday schedule.

BICYCLES

Bike racks are located on the front of the bus. Riders are responsible for loading and unloading bicycles on a first-service basis. If you want to use the bike rack:

- Please advise the driver know
 - Load your bike onto the rack, then board the bus
 - When you get off the bus, tell the driver you will be removing your bike from the rack
 - Unload the bike, move away from the bus and wave to the driver to indicate it is safe to drive away
- Passengers use the bike racks at their own risk. Glenn Transit Service assumes no responsibility for damage or loss to the bicycle or any items thereon.

RIDER RULES OF CONDUCT

To keep service enjoyable for all riders, passengers are asked to observe the following rules of conduct while on the bus:

- Follow all safety instructions given by the driver
- Do not disturb the driver while bus is in motion
- Seats at the front of the bus are designated for the elderly or persons with disabilities.
- Never block the center aisle. Strollers must be closed while in transport.

Passenger Conduct:

- No illegal activity of any kind will be tolerated while on board the bus
- Shirts and shoes are required for all passengers
- Respect other passengers' privacy
- Cell phones must be silenced while riding. **Reminder**—other passengers can hear your conversations; please keep cell phone conversation to a minimum
- No abusive, threatening, vulgar or obscene language or actions allowed.
- No use of radios, audio or video devices without ear-phones
- Personal hygiene maintained at a reasonable level that includes body odor so offensive that others complain and/or vacate the immediate area
- No defacing, marring or damaging any part of the bus. Violators will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law
- No smoking or use of any nicotine or smoking device which causes any smoke, mist, vapor or the like emitted through use on the bus or within 25 feet of the bus
- No littering. Dispose of trash in containers located at the front of the bus
- No eating or drinking
- No soliciting
- No fighting, rowdiness, or horseplay. Riders engaging in physical abuse or causing physical injury to another rider or driver may be subject to immediate and permanent suspension of service and possible criminal activity
- No leaning against the doors
- Do not lie down on seats. Feet and shoes are not allowed on or over the top of seats
- Maintain a firm hold on all personal items. Remember to take all personal items when departing. Carry-on items are not allowed on the seats

Following Items Are Not Allowed On The Bus:

- Open food and/or drink containers. Containers with secure lids are OK.
- Animals: Only properly documented service animals or animals secured in an appropriate animal cage allowed. Animals are not allowed on bus seats.
- Guns, firearms or weapons
- Flammable or hazardous substances
- Alcoholic beverages
