CHANGES

- A. II. INSTRUCTIONS, CONDITIONS, AND NOTICES TO OFFERERS
 - a. The pre-qualification conference attendance will not be mandatory. Also, the pre-qualification documentation will not be mandatory.
 - b. Date to respond to questions e-mailed to PROPOSERS will be changed from November 3rd to November 6th.
- B. CRITERIA TO DETERMINE PROPOSALS WITHIN A COMPETITIVE RANGE (STEP 2)
 - a. Additional points will be awarded to those offerors who attended the pre-qualification conference and submitted the pre-qualification documentation. Please note that this is related to the proposal evaluation.
- C. PFICE PROPOSAL FORMS
 - a. CPI will be calculated using the Department of Industrial Relation's numbers.

RFP QUESTIONS

- 1. The County added a day (Saturday) for DAR service but didn't add any more hours. Will more hours be added to account for this change?
 - a. **DAR will only run-on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.**
- 2. Can we substitute a letter of credit for the performance bond, same as we did for the last contract?
 - a. **Yes.**

3. Openers in this contract are for a service change in excess of 20%. Last contract was 10%. Given that inflation has increased rapidly, would it be fair to stick with the established 10%?
 - a. 20% is most suitable.
4. We based our increases on the CPI for All Consumers, West Region for the last contract. This RFP states increases should not exceed 90% of the U.S. City Average. What is the justification for changing this and why only 90% when inflation continues to rise rapidly?
 - a. 90% helps mitigate CPI increases that are well above average.
5. The RFP has 11 operation vehicles listed, and currently Willows has 11 operation vehicles on the vehicle schedule with 8 of the 11 in service and insured. Will Willows be putting all 11 in service to be insured?
 - a. 8 vehicles will be insured.
