Executive Director Zoppi reported that Glenn County has submitted an application for ACES aware funding.		
D. Trinity County	Board Member Liz Hamilton mentioned the big push in vaccine distribution, reports the county as a whole has become great as pivoting as the plans/snow/vaccine information changes. Hired an individual to deal with landlord engagement as rent is very high in Trinity County.
