	that the quarterly COC meeting will be held November 17, 2021. Working to continue to make sure that sub-agreements are in place.	
B. Glenn County	Board Member Phil Zabell reported on the radio vault on top of St. Johns mountain was repaired by October 14, just before the storm. Discussed the unmet needs roundtable supporting the 2021 wildfires. Board Member Bill Wathen reported that Habitat for Humanity is securing the property of Orland Inn behind Subway. Have ability to add units – currently 14-15 units, with availability to 29-30. No place like home, part of the MHSA plan, has secured property in NE Willows.	
C. Trinity County	Board Member Sheri White reported that they are continuing working with landlords on different housing monies and repairs available. Working with August Complex families to get back into housing. They will also do the same for the Monument and the River Fire.
