California Relief Grant Program





Good afternoon business partners,

We are excited to announce that with the signing of the 2021 state budget, the California Relief Grant Program received an additional \$1.5 billion for an additional three rounds of funding! Information on the next three rounds:

- Round 7: This is a closed round and only available to eligible applicants who were
 waitlisted in certain previous rounds (new applications will not be accepted during this
 round). Waitlisted applicants do not need to reapply. Keep an eye out for any emails
 from Lendistry with more information. Round 7 is open now and closes on September
 16th.
- Round 8: For nonprofit cultural institutions only. This round opens on August 27th and will close on Sept 8th. Eligible nonprofit cultural institutions must complete a new application even if they already applied in Rounds 1, 2, 5 or 6; nonprofit cultural institutions that applied in Round 4 do not need to reapply (Round 4 was specific to nonprofit arts and cultural institutions). Grants will only be available to nonprofit cultural institutions that did not receive funding in any of the previous rounds. FYI, the definition of an "Eligible Nonprofit Cultural Institution" can be found on page 4 of the updated Program Overview and Application Guide HERE.
- Round 9: For NEW applicants and waitlisted applicants from any of the previous rounds. This Round opens on September 9th and will close on September 30th. New applicants will need to apply HERE. Applicants not selected in any of the previous Rounds 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, or 7 do not need to re-apply and will be automatically moved into Round 9.
