Re: Special Joint WAC/TAC meetings

At their August 18, 2015 meeting, the Board of Supervisors (Board) voted to adopt a "moratorium prohibiting the issuance of well permits by Glenn County Environmental Health, effective immediately, to be reviewed by the Glenn County Board of Supervisors on March 15, 2016, or sooner if the Water Advisory Committee, Technical Advisory Committee, and the Water component of the Agriculture Department present to the Board of Supervisors, and the Board approves and adopts by ordinance, a revised groundwater management plan to better protect and preserve this limited and vital natural resource."

There was lengthy board discussion and public input at the meeting. Much of the concerns of both the Board and public focused on the need for exceptions to the moratorium, especially for domestic wells. The Board was unable to agree on a definition for domestic wells and after discussion issued a Minute Order to the WAC that tasks the WAC to develop recommendations for exceptions to the moratorium for the Board to consider at their September 15, 2015 meeting. Failing that, the Board will rely upon recommendations from County staff for their September 15 meeting. This is an extremely tight schedule for a body such as the WAC, but it is achievable. As such, I am scheduling two special joint WAC/TAC meetings for Tuesday August 25 and Tuesday September 1 in order to complete this task. The August 25 meeting will be held at 1:30 at the Willows City Council Chambers. The September 1 meeting will be held at 1:30 at the GCID conference room.

I realize that this is a tight timeframe for many WAC members to consult their respective governance bodies for formal guidance, but I believe that recommending the exemption of domestic wells from this moratorium is not a controversial issue. Furthermore, I ask that the WAC consider recommending exemptions for replacement agricultural wells and for monitoring

wells required by regulatory agencies. Lisa will be sending out draft language for our review by the end of this week.

At this point I am scheduling two meetings as stated above, but will cancel the September 1 meeting if the WAC can agree upon a recommendation August 25. To do this there must be a quorum of the WAC in order to take formal action upon a recommendation. Thus, it is important that you attend.
