- II. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES:</u> The minutes were continued to the next regular meeting of the committees.
- III. AGENDA ITEMS:
 - A. Public Comment: None.
 - B. Discussion and/or Action Items:
 - 1. **TAC Report-**Lisa Hunter mentioned that the TAC met in May. The committee reviewed and discussed the 2013 spring groundwater levels, the hydrographs and associated data representing

dedicated monitoring wells as possible replacements for BMO wells, and an education and outreach program ideas that will be presented at the July 10 Glenn County Farm Bureau meeting.

2. Announcements-

- **a.**) BOS Meeting-Larry Domenighini mentioned that he and Lisa plan on presenting an update to the Board of Supervisors in August 2013. If anyone has anything they would like to present please contact Larry or Lisa.
- 3. **Water Transfers for 2013-**Since the last WAC meeting there has been continued coordination with RD 1004 (letter dated June 11, 2013 included in the agenda packet) and GCID with the proposed groundwater substitution transfers for 2013.
- 4. **Presentation on Land Use Changes-**Grant Davids and Byron Clark of Davids Engineering gave a powerpoint presentation on the results of an analysis of land use changes in the Sacramento Valley conducted by his firm with particular emphasis on Glenn County.
- 5. Western Glenn County Water Level Declines-Lisa Hunter gave a powerpoint presentation which showed the growth in acres over the last several years in the western Glenn County, graphs of the water districts showing their allocations and deliveries, a map of wells monitored in Glenn County by DWR and select hydrographs was included. Also discussed was an email from Allan Fulton discussing the potential development of a full cost analysis of groundwater pumping and a handout titled "Water Advisory Committee (WAC)-Points for discussion only" presented by Sandy Denn.

An Adhoc committee of both WAC and TAC members was created to consider options for further investigation. The committee and potentially a few landowners in the area will meet a few times and report back to the WAC in November or December. The following individuals were appointed to the committee:
